General Eligibility & Nomination Information

Eligibility

To be eligible for nomination, individuals must:

- be a **registered student** at the University of Roehampton
 - be studying on either a **full-time or part-time course**
 - hold a valid **Sport Roehampton membership**

Who Can Submit a Nomination

Nominations may be submitted by:

- any student with a **Sport Roehampton** or **Active Roehampton** membership
 - a **club member, captain or committee member**
 - a member of **Sport & Active Communities staff**, including coaches
 - any **University staff member** who is aware of a student's achievement through their involvement with students

How to Submit a Nomination

All nominations must:

- be completed using the **official nomination form**
- be submitted via the **RSU website**
- be received by the published **closing date**

Late nominations will not be accepted.

Important Notes

- There is **no numerical limit** on the number of **Bronze, Silver or Gold Awards** that may be awarded, provided nominees meet the relevant criteria.
- Awards may be given in any sport:
 - recognised by **Sport England**, and/or
 - included within the **Sport Roehampton student sport programme**

- The **Awards Panel** will make the final decision on all awards.
 - **There is no right of appeal.**

 - the Roehampton Students' Union
 - a selection of student representatives

Guidance for Writing a Strong Nomination

When submitting a nomination, please ensure that you:

- address the **specific criteria** for the award category
- provide **clear and relevant examples**
- explain the nominee's **impact, contribution or achievement**
- demonstrate how the nominee has gone **above and beyond expectations**
- where applicable, explain why a nominee is deserving of a **higher level of award**

Strong nominations will provide **evidence, context** and **specific examples** rather than general statements of praise.
